Our largest plot on the Littlebrook redevelopment is still progressing on schedule. Having recently completed the external building, we are now beginning our internal works.

The Development

Our team have completed the wrapping of the building and have now commenced the construction of the internal floors, thanks to the now functioning on site concrete plant.

Internal fit out of the building has started and will continue with the installation of the solar panels and equipment on the roof. The new external yards and internal access roads are being formed around the building and the new multilevel car park has been substantially completed.

Alongside this, our adjacent plots are being prepared for future development.

Supporting the Local Community

Since we started development at Littlebrook we have put down firm roots in the community, having recently signed a 5-year sponsorship with community owned Dartford FC and since March we have donated c£20,000 in food and book vouchers to YMCA Thames Gateway; helping to feed and house those most impacted by Covid-19 and providing educational material to young people out of school.

This month we've teamed up with YMCA and National Grid to run our **Christmas Happiness Hamper** incentive on site. Everyone who is involved in our development is being encouraged to donate food and essential items that we will then pack and deliver to provide extra support to families who need it this Christmas.

Our goal is to exceed 150 hampers, with any surplus supplies to be distributed to local food banks.

Virtual Work Experience with The Leigh UTC

During the half term week, we organised a 5-day Virtual Work Experience Programme for the students at The Leigh UTC. After learning of the outstanding numbers of young people at risk of losing the opportunity to participate in a placement due to Covid-19 restrictions, the project wanted to identify ways to deliver meaningful educational value whilst observing the safety measures in place.

17 enthusiastic students took part in a series of diverse and vibrant sessions relating to the construction industry and were given the opportunity to learn about the variety of different roles and routes into construction.

The programme included Q&A sessions with senior members of the team, construction related games, virtual site tours, as well as career development workshops and exercises.

They then completed an end of week project to apply everything they learnt during the week.
